Application by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales, industrial organisation of employees.

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. The Toymakers' Employees (State) Conciliation Committee published 26 March 1993 (274 I.G. 156), be dissolved.

2. There be established a new Toymakers' Employees (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Employees engaged in the manufacture of toys (other than those made of sheet metal) in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting storemen and/or packers.

3. The said committee shall consist of one representative of employers and one representative of employees.

4. The representative of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales.

5. The representative of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales.

6. This order shall take effect on and from 9 November 1995.
