Application by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales, industrial organisation of employees.

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. The Nurseries Employees (State) Conciliation Committee published 21 May 1993 (275 I.G. 160) be dissolved.
2. There be established a new Nurseries Employees (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

All employees who are employed in rural industries within the meaning of section 5(4) of the *Industrial Relations Act 1991*:

- (1) in nurseries; or
- (2) at clearing, fencing, trenching, draining or otherwise preparing land for the abovementioned purposes,

within the State,

except persons within the jurisdiction of the following Conciliation Committees —

Horticultural and Garden Employees (State);

Fruit Growing Industry (State).

3. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

4. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales.

5. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales.
6. This order shall take effect on and from 4 December 1995.
