**ORDER**

The Commission orders that —

1. The Storemen and Packers, Wholesale Paint, Varnish, Oil and Colour Stores (State) Conciliation Committee published 9 July 1993 (275 I.G. 1062), be dissolved.
2. There be established a new Storemen and Packers, Wholesale Paint, Varnish, Oil and Colour Stores (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Storemen and packers in paint or colour stores or factories, including storemen and packers, who for the purpose of and in the course of their work as storemen and packers, use mechanical or electrical appliances, employed in receiving, stacking, storing, packing and/or preparing for transport or delivery of oil and grease used in the paint and varnish industry, or paint, varnish, white, red or pig lead, colour or other merchandise or goods of any description, in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

*excepting* employees of —

Broken Hill Proprietary Company Limited at Newcastle;  
Australian Wire Industries Pty Ltd at its Newcastle Wiremill.

3. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.
4. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by The Employers' Federation of New South Wales and one by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales (Industrial).

5. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the National Union of Workers, New South Wales Branch.
6. This order shall take effect on and from 19 February 1996.
